Scott started his refereeing career in 1981 in Yorkton, Saskatchewan. He progressed through the levels until attaining his International level in 2007. Scott travelled to the United States for international tournaments including the NORCECA Olympic Qualification tournament in California. Within Canada, he has refereed over 10 years at either the college or university National Championships.

Scott's level of commitment and assuming various administrative roles within provincial and national programs is unparalleled. In Saskatchewan, he has been the Regional Officials Chairperson for seven years, the Level III and IV Coordinator for over ten years and has been a Referee Committee Executive Member since 2000.

From a Volleyball Canada perspective, Scott was the National Official Chairperson from 2012-2020; Chair/Member of the Level IV Promotions Committee since 2009; Referee Supervisor, Mentor, Assignor and Clinician since the 1990s to Present; and has fulfilled the role of Referee Supervisor at 10 college or university National Championships.
