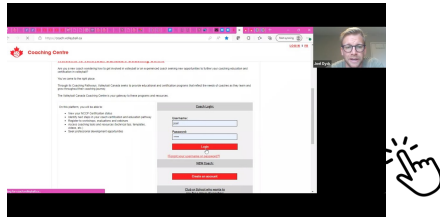

## First and Second Year 17-18U

Head Coaches for 17-18U Divisions Require:

1. Criminal Record Check with vulnerable sector check Jan 1, 2021 or newer
2. Respect In Sport for Activity Leaders. [https://sasksrc.respectgroupinc.com/koala\\_final/](https://sasksrc.respectgroupinc.com/koala_final/) (RIS only needs to be done once. Doesn't expire)
3. Screening Disclosure form (done at TeamLinkt Registration)
4. Advanced Development Coach Workshop attendance, please register here: <https://www.saskvolleyball.ca/nccp-workshops/>
5. Making Headway in Sport (only needed to complete once)
6. Making Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation (only needed to complete once)
7. Foundations of Volleyball (only needed to complete once)

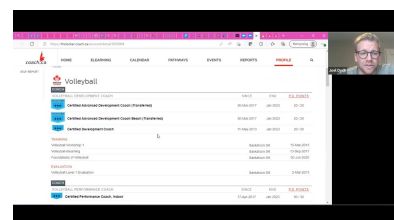

**SANCTIONS: Any Persons in Authority** who are missing any or all the requirements in Section B (below) will be ineligible to participate with their team as a **Persons in Authority** at a Nationals for that year and will not be listed on the final team roster.

### MINIMUM CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR HEAD COACHES:

All **Head Coaches** listed on any Nationals roster must meet the requirements below for the age class that they are coaching.

**SANCTIONS: Head Coaches** who do not meet the requirements for that year (outlined below) will be subject to a \$250 CAD fine, payable prior to participation in that year's Nationals.

15U	<b>Head Coaches</b> participating at a 14U, 15U or 16U Nationals for the <b>1-time</b> are required to have successfully completed a <b>DEVELOPMENT COACH WORKSHOP</b> .
16U	<b>Head Coaches</b> participating at a 14U, 15U or 16U Nationals for <b>3-time or more</b> are required to have <b>CERTIFIED DEVELOPMENT COACH</b> status.
17U	<b>Head Coaches</b> participating at a 17U or 18U Nationals for the <b>1-time</b> are required to have successfully completed an <b>ADVANCED DEVELOPMENT COACH (INDOOR) WORKSHOP</b> .
18U	<b>Head Coaches</b> participating at a 17U or 18U Nationals for the <b>3-time or more</b> are required to have <b>CERTIFIED ADVANCED DEVELOPMENT COACH</b> status.
<p><b>IMPORTANT NOTE:</b> Head Coaches who have achieved <b>Certified</b> status in their appropriate context are still required to complete the mandatory requirements and maintain <b>Active</b> status in the NCCP Locker. <b>Coaches with an 'Inactive' status are not eligible.</b> Please refer to <a href="#">Volleyball Canada's NCCP Certification Maintenance Guide</a> on how to remain <b>Active</b>.</p> <p>A coach that has moved from 14U-16U into 17U-18U age group must have the appropriate requirements for the 17U-18U category. A coach who has the requirements for 17U-18U, is eligible for 14U-16U, however is encouraged to obtain education for the appropriate context.</p> <p>An exemption application to the Certification Requirements after the March 30, 2024 deadline, will <b>only be considered</b> under the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1<sup>st</sup> year Head Coach at the 14U or 15U category. This will be verified through the Locker based on mandatory requirements dates of completion, i.e. Initial Locker Activity - Fall 2023-Winter 2024.</li> <li>2. A head coach is assigned to a team roster, after March 30, 2024 – based on approved roster changes by VC.</li> <li>3. A PTA is unable to offer a workshop or provide an evaluator due to unforeseen circumstances prior to the deadline.</li> <li>4. There is confirmation through The Locker of professional development taken within the previous 3 months (Jan-March 2024) not including the mandatory requirements.</li> </ol> <p>A request for an exemption will be available after March 30, 2024 through a Formstack link. Any exemptions provided by the PTA are not applicable to the VC Nationals exemption process. An exemption application does NOT guarantee an exemption will be provided.</p>
