## SASK VOLLEYBALL PROGRAMMING SANCTIONS

The following are sanction guidelines dealing with rules specific to Sask Volleyball programming only. This document does not deal with:

- On court issues that are already covered by the 2024 VC Rulebook.
- Issues that have been identified involving misconduct, maltreatment and prohibited behavior.
   Such issues will be reported directly to the Office of the Sport Integrity Commissioner, (OSIC). See Sask Sport Safe Sport Policy.

Recruitment: - Including clubs, teams or personnel that violate recruiting guidelines, (see club guide page 14) Unsuccessful attempts to recruit athletes that violate said guidelines will also be subject to sanctions.	Club's 1 <sup>st</sup> offense in a given year: - personnel initiating and/or participating in any non-compliant recruiting is/are suspended from all Sask VB sanctioned events for 1 calendar year from the date of the sanction and the team associated with the personnel initiating and/or participating in any non-compliant recruiting is ineligible to compete in the next Sask VB competition in which that team is registered, (a Sask Cup or Provincials).
- This also includes clubs that attempt to add players to roster after "roster freeze" deadline without prior approval of Sask Volleyball's <b>Program Director</b> .	Club's 2 <sup>nd</sup> offense in a given year: - <b>above sanctions</b> are applied, plus the <b>team</b> associated with the personnel initiating and/or participating in any non-compliant recruiting is <b>ineligible</b> to compete in the remainder of Sask VB competitions for that age class season (Sask Cups and Provincials).
	Club's subsequent recruiting violations in a given year: - personnel initiating and/or participating in any non-compliant recruiting is/are suspended from all Sask VB sanctioned events for 2 calendar years from the date of the sanction said Club will be suspended from all Sask VB sanctioned events for 1 calendar year from the date of the sanction.
Other:	- Other violations regarding Sask Volleyball Rules and Policy not documented above will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Consequences of such violations, if applicable, will also be determined on a case-by-case basis.

NOTE: Entry fees that may have already been paid will NOT be returned if a sanction results in a team being deemed ineligible for a Sask VB competition. This is in addition to any penalties/fines that are also levied against offending teams.
