



Sask Volleyball Referee Committee Scholarship Program

The annual Sask Volleyball Referee Committee Scholarship will be awarded to the high school senior(s) and/or current college student(s) who best meet the requirements set forth by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship awards are limited to cover tuition and fees. Award amounts are at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee but will not be less than \$500.

The Selection Committee will review and score all submitted applications. Applicant's references may be contacted by telephone. The Scholarship Committee may choose to interview applicants. The scholarship recipients will be notified by June 30.

Guidelines for the Scholarship Program

Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors and students currently enrolled at any college or university in Saskatchewan. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution in the student's name. ****For 2020, when the educational institutions announce they will re-open.****

Student applicants must be an active volleyball referee who meet the following requirements:

1. Plan to attend, or currently attend an accredited college or university in Saskatchewan on a full time basis.
2. Must have acquired acceptance to, or be enrolled at the college of his/her choice and must be an enrolled full-time student for the fall semester.
3. Attend at least one (1) referee clinic and
4. Officiate at least one (1) Provincial Volleyball Championship in the season the application is submitted. ****For 2020 Scholarship, list your reffing activity during 2019/2020****

Student applicant should note any special financial needs on their application form.

All applications and supporting documents must be received no later than May 31.

Please advise your high school/college registrar of this deadline for submission of transcripts and other supporting documentation. Student applicants that have completed one full academic year at a college/university do not need to submit High School transcripts.
