The positions will be based in Regina, Saskatoon, and Prince Albert, with number or hires depending on program needs. If you are creative, an excellent communicator, and have a passion for volleyball, this opportunity is for you!

Reporting to the Executive Director, the successful candidates will be responsible for planning, organizing, and delivering a volleyball programs. The program involvement may include Indoor and Beach Provincial Championships, Indoor and Beach Provincial Team, Youth and Adult Beach programs, camps, and leagues, and other duties as required.

Qualifications

- Successful completion of a Police Records check before commencing employment.

- Registered as a student in a Kinesiology, Education, or Health-related field.
