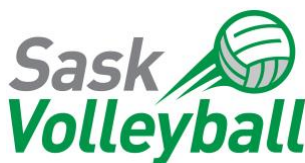

COACHING OPPORTUNITY

2024 Sask Summer Games Beach Team Coaches

Sask Volleyball is a non-profit Provincial Sport Governing Body whose purpose is to develop and promote the sport of volleyball across Saskatchewan. The organization offers programs and services designed for a variety of ages and abilities, involving both grassroots and competitive, indoor and beach volleyball.

Sask Volleyball is seeking to hire Coaches for the 2024 Sask Summer Games. One District coach will be required for both men and women teams. Only athletes born in 2009 or later are eligible. The positions will report to the High-Performance Manager and the Technical Director. The following positions are available:

Critical Behaviors

- Superior oral and written communication skills.
- Exceptional organization skills.
- Advanced degree of technical & tactical knowledge in the sport of volleyball.
- Prioritize tasks and manage schedules.
- Work independently or in collaboration with a group.

Responsibilities – Including but not limited to:

- Coordinate the selection camp within your district.
 - Secure volleyball facility and equipment.
 - Promote open tryout to all schools and clubs.
- Supervise athletes during training and competition.
- Create a training plan.
- Lead a competitive program.
- Observe and assist with Canada Summer Games Beach selection camp (Date TBD)
- Review Beach rules with the High-Performance Manager prior to tryouts
 - Not required for Certified Advanced Development Beach Coaches
- Oversee team administrative duties.

- Review team budget with Sask Volleyball High-Performance Manager
- Provide an estimated team budget to families at tryouts (cost/athlete)
- Follow guidelines in Volleyball Tech Package and Sask Sport Handbook

Qualifications

- NCCP Development Coach Certification. Candidates working towards certification will be considered.
- Previous coaching experience.
- Possess a valid driver's license, a reliable vehicle, and a willingness to travel within the province (Travel Policy applicable).
- Successful completion of a Police Records check before commencing employment.

Assets

- High-performance playing experience.
- Certified Advanced Development or Performance Coach.
- Degree in Kinesiology, Education or related field.
- Familiar with the Long-term Athlete Development model of physical literacy.

Remuneration (Not covered by Sask Volleyball)

- Each district team is responsible to recoup all gym, coaches travel, equipment cost, incurred during the training period.
- Saskatchewan Games Council fee is \$100.00 per athlete, no fee for coaches.
- Walk out uniforms for athletes and coaches provided by Sask Games Council
- Teams are responsible for their competition uniform costs and must coordinate orders through Sask Volleyball
- Up to a \$1000 honorarium/coach permitted.
 - Amount(s) will reflect coaching qualifications and level of responsibilities
- Up to \$20 tryout fee/athlete is permitted.
 - Money collected will help lower overall team expenses.

Program Timelines

- Start and End Dates:
 - 2024 – 1 day selection Camp (June 9th)
 - 2024 – June-July Training
 - 2024 – July 24-27 Competition

Facilities & Training

- Recommend 2-4 hours of practice/week in June, 4-6 hours of practice/week in July.
- Each team must provide their own balls for training.
- Practice facility must have an adequate volleyball court, net, posts and antennas.

Competition

- Practice, match schedule and rules provided in Technical Package online.

- Teams will be bused to and from their district and the competition site.
- Accommodations and meals provided for coaches and athletes.
- Teams must attend the opening and closing ceremonies.
- All Athletes, Coaches, and Managers must stay at the Athletes Village for the full duration of the competition.
- Teams are responsible for supervising and securing their own belongings.

Deadline to apply: January 15, 2024
